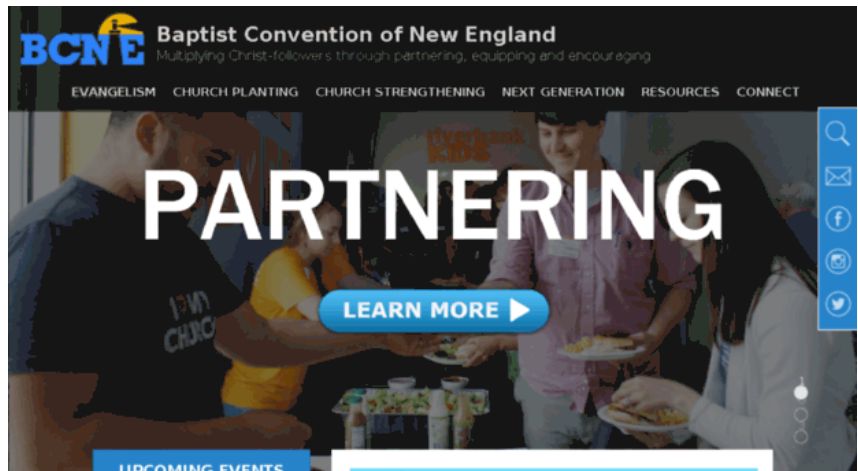

The Salem Baptist Association Executive Committee had the privilege of hearing the ministry needs of The Baptist Convention of New England (BCNE) at our meeting this past Monday evening. Sam Taylor, Greater Boston Area Coordinator, Erik Maloy, Pastor of the First Church of Charlestown, MA, and Joel Stoddert, Pastor of Lyndon Center Free Baptist Church of Lyndon, VT shared with us their needs.

The BCNE is made up of Southern Baptist Churches in Maine, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut and New Hampshire with a total population of about 14.5 million people. Currently there are 350 SBC churches in New England with the need for many more.

The four least religious states in the U.S. are located in New England, as are five of America's most post-Christian cities. This isn't surprising, since almost one in five New England residents say they have no religious affiliation at all.
